

Access from / to the airport "ELEFTHERIOS VENIZELOS" to the city of Athens

AIRPORT PUBLIC TRANSPORT SERVICES

Three express bus lines serve the Athens International Airport (A.I.A.) "ELEFTHERIOS VENIZELOS".

E94 METRO ST."ETHNIKI AMYNA" - A.I.A. EXPRESS Connecting the airport with the nearest metro station "Ethniki Amyna" (connection with metro line 3).

E95 SYNTAGMA - A.I.A. EXPRESS Connecting the airport with Syntagma Square - city center (connection with metro lines 2 and 3).

E96 PEIRAIAS - A.I.A. EXPRESS Connecting the airport with the port of Peiraias (connection with metro line 1).

AIRPORT TICKET

The ticket price for the airport express lines is 2,93 euro. It allows for unlimited travel by all transport modes (bus, trolley, metro) for 24 hours from the time of its validation during first trip (validate only once).

The 24-hour ticket can be purchased from the drivers of the airport buses, at all metro stations and at the blue or yellow ticket kiosks of the Athens Public Transport Network.

This ticket can be used, irrespective of traveling to/from airport, as a daily ticket by those who wish to explore the city using public transport.

MORE ABOUT FARES AND TICKETS

○ BUSES AND TROLLEY BUSES

The standard ticket for buses and trolley buses costs 0,44 euro. Tickets are sold at the blue or yellow ticket kiosks of the Athens Public Transport Network and at the metro station of lines 2 and 3.

○ METRO

The metro ticket of 0,73 euro allows for traveling on all lines (any transfer from one line to another is permitted) in one direction within 90 minutes from the time of its validation.

The metro ticket of 0,59 euro allows for traveling within one or two subsequent zones of line 1. Metro tickets are sold only at the metro stations.

NOTICE: Children under the age of six travel free. (only for METRO)

DO'S

- Validate your ticket by inserting it into the validating machine as soon as you board on the vehicle or you enter a metro station.
- Keep it safe till the end of your trip. Otherwise, you are liable to an on-the-spot fine, ranging from 17,6 euro to 29,32 euro.

DON'Ts

- Do not validate your 24-hour ticket more than once.

Timetables are posted on all bus stops.

General Information

- The departure area is located at the first floor of the Main Terminal building while arrival hall and baggage-claim area is situated on the ground floor.
- 1.500 short term parking spaces signed P1&P2. They are in front of the International and Schengen arrival area.
- Cost: 2.93 euro per hour and 2.05 euro per additional hour.
- 3.000 long term parking spaces signed P3. Cost: 9.97 euro per day.
- Express buses are available to and from the airport as follows:
 - E94: Ethniki Amyna - Airport - Ethniki Amyna
 - E95: Syntagma - Airport - Syntagma
 - E96: Peiraias - Airport - PeiraiasCost per passenger: 2,93 euro oneway.
- Taxi: Syntagma - Airport ca 19,06 euro.
