Professor Miller (PhD University of Texas at Austin) holds the Bauer Professorship Organizational Studies at the University of Houston, USA. Previously, he was a faculty member at Baylor University and Wake Forest University and visiting professor at Duke University and Cornell University. At Baylor, he served as Director of the Center for Executive Education. At Wake Forest, he served as an area coordinator, an associate dean, and a program director.

He is an active member of the Academy of Management and the Strategic Management Society, having served in such roles as Associate editor of the U.S. Academy's most recent journal, Academy of Management Discoveries, associate editor for Academy of Management Journal and editorial board member of the Strategic Management Journal and Organization Science.

Awards and honors include the 2011 Academy of Management Review best paper award, the Outstanding Young Researcher Award (from Baylor University), teaching awards from Wake Forest University and Duke University (where he was a guest instructor), and designation as the Farr Fellow in Leadership at Wake Forest.

Professor Miller's published research focuses on the functioning of management teams, the design of organizational structures and management systems, and the design of strategic decision processes. His publications have appeared in word leading academic journals such as: Academy of Management Review, Academy of Management Journal, Strategic Management Journal, Organization Science, Academy of Management Executive, Journal of Organizational Behavior, and Journal of Behavioral Decision Making.

Professor Miller has worked with a number of managers and executives.
