<b>Levels of exchange (cycles)</b>	In AUEB undergraduate studies are of an official 4-year duration (240 ECTS credits). Incoming students having completed a 3-year 1 <sup>st</sup> cycle degree programme are accepted at the AUEB 4 <sup>th</sup> year of studies taking advanced level courses in English.
<b>Deadlines for the nomination of exchange students</b>	Mid July for each year. (For the autumn semester, for the spring semester or for the whole following academic year) Nominations for the spring semester can be accepted also till mid November.
<b>Deadlines for the receipt of applications and other documents of exchange students</b>	By mid July for each year. (For the autumn semester and the whole following academic year) By mid November for the spring semester
<b>Application forms needed</b>	The 3 forms plus an official proof of knowledge of English language, to be mailed to the Erasmus+ Office by our partners and NOT by the students individually.

Courses in Greek language taught to Greek students are also offered to Erasmus+ incomers knowing Greek language.
<b>Minimum requirement for incoming students</b>	- They should present a Learning Agreement with 30 ECTS credits per semester in order to be accepted as Erasmus students. - European Card of Health Insurance must be shown upon registration.

<p><b>Linguistic requirements</b></p>	<p>Evidence of English Language Competence equal (or higher) to Level B2 of the Common European Framework of Reference for Languages, as attested by the relevant certificates.</p> <p>Evidence of English Language Competence can also be provided with an official certificate issued by the home institution.</p>
<p><b>Minimum requirement for outgoing students</b></p>	<p>All outgoing students should take a study program of 30 ECTS credits per semester. They must submit with their application an official proof of knowledge of the language taught at the host institution.</p>
