

# Quality Assurance Policy

With the **highest possible evaluation across all individual criteria**, the Internal Quality Assurance System (IQAS) of the Athens University of Economics and Business (AUEB) has been re-certified by the Hellenic Authority for Higher Education (HAHE). The University demonstrated **excellent performance and received outstanding assessments on the seven core criteria** that form the framework for awarding quality certification.

As part of the certification process, an external audit was conducted, including an on-site visit by a five-member team of evaluators and experts appointed by HAHE. The evaluation committee held a series of meetings with the University's Administration, Heads of Departments, members of the Teaching and Research Staff from the Internal Evaluation Teams, students at all levels of study, heads of academic sectors, administrative staff representatives,

alumni, and social partners. In addition, the committee visited classrooms, research laboratories, and other facilities to assess the completeness and quality of the University's infrastructure.

This re-certification **confirms the effectiveness, maturity, and comprehensiveness of the IQAS** at AUEB, in full alignment with the Quality Certification Standard for Internal Quality Assurance Systems of Higher Education Institutions and with the principles and guidelines of the European Higher Education Area.

AUEB remains committed to consistently and responsibly investing in the quality of its educational mission, thereby strengthening the trust of students, academic staff, administrative personnel, and society at large.

The certification is valid for five years.



# TIMELINE

## Major Milestones in the History of the Athens University of Economics and Business



1903

The national benefactor Grigorios Maraslis donates to the public the amount of 250,000 gold drachmas in order to house the Academy of Commerce and Industry in Athens.



1919

Eleftherios Venizelos invites to Greece the professor of the University of Lausanne Georges Paillard to whom he assigns the drafting of the founding report of the Higher School of Commerce, following the model of the corresponding School of the University of Lausanne.



1920

Based on the Paillard proposal, the Higher School of Commercial Studies is established.

170 students are enrolled in the first year of operation of the School. The first subjects taught are: Political Economy, Accounting, Chemistry, General Mathematics, Commercial Economics, Civil and Commercial Law.



1983

The Research Center (ELKE) is established, within which the Center for Economic Research is established with the aim of developing research and disseminating scientific knowledge.



1978

Graduate studies, leading to a two-year Master's degree and a PhD degree, are organized for the first time in Greece by the Department of Economics.



1963

The differentiation of studies in the directions of Economics and Business Sciences starts from the third year.



1955

The duration of studies increased from three to four years, and the fourth year, studies are organized into two streams: Economics and Business Sciences.



ASOEE is now under the Ministry of Education and is recognized as equivalent to the University of Applied Sciences (NTUA), and is hierarchically placed at the level of the University.



The School is finally housed in the main University building, the Megaron on Patission Street.

The Students Association is founded aiming at the "moral and spiritual improvement of its members".



1926

Higher School of Commercial Studies is renamed to Higher School of Commercial Sciences (ASOEE).



The Athens University of Economics and Business provides the opportunity to conduct Postdoctoral Research to scientists with strong research potential, in thematic areas that fall within the research interests and/or academic fields of its academic departments.

Postdoctoral Research at AUEB:

- Offers **specialization** in the scientific fields covered by the University's Departments, as well as in related areas
  - Aims at the **production of high-quality scientific knowledge**, fostering the development of innovative ideas and applications
  - Supports the **advancement and strengthening of scientists** capable of making a substantial contribution to the progress of science, research, and society
- Postdoctoral activity constitutes a source of academic prestige and international recognition for AUEB and its Departments, while simultaneously contributing to the qualitative and quantitative enhancement of the University's research output.

## Research Center

The Research Center of the Athens University of Economics and Business (ELKE/AUEB) was established in 1983, with the mission of strengthening theoretical and applied research in the scientific fields served by the University.

The primary purpose of ELKE is the **allocation and management of funding** originating from national, European, or international sources, concerning:

- Research, educational, training, and development programs
- Continuing education and lifelong learning projects
- Provision of scientific, technological, or other specialized services
- Preparation of studies, laboratory testing, and analyses
- Provision of expert opinions, drafting of technical specifications, and other related activities

These activities strengthen the **link between research and education** and leverage the University's high-level

scientific potential.

Since its establishment to date, ELKE/AUEB has supported more than **800 research projects** in the University's main scientific pillars: Economics, Business Administration, Statistics, Informatics, Marketing, Accounting, and Management Science.

**Funding resources** are derived mainly from:

- The **European Union**
- **Public and private bodies**
- **International organizations**
- The University itself

The scientific collaborators of ELKE/AUEB enjoy full academic freedom in the selection of research topics, methodologies, and the dissemination of their results. Students may also participate in ELKE projects, further strengthening the connection between research and the educational process.





## AUEB's Property Management & Development S.A.

The **AUEB's Property Management & Development S.A.** (EADP) of the Athens University of Economics and Business S.A. was established in 1993 by decision of the Senate of the Athens University of Economics and Business and operates as a **Private Law Legal Entity**. Its share capital is wholly owned by the University.

The Company's mission is the utilization and management of:

- the movable and immovable property of the University, and
- the intellectual property generated within the framework of AUEB's academic and research activities.

EADP AUEB S.A. develops initiatives aimed at strengthening the University's financial resources, improving its infrastructure, promoting research and education, and disseminating the knowledge produced to society and the market. Due to its legal form, the Company operates with flexibility, speed, and efficiency, undertaking a wide range of activities, either in collaboration with members of the academic community or with third parties, organizations, and enterprises.

### AUEB's Property Management & Development S.A.

EADP AUEB S.A. offers the following services:

- **Management and utilization** of endowments for the awarding of scholarships to AUEB students.
- **Organization of conferences and events**, as well as the leasing of university facilities to third parties.
- **Implementation of funded research projects** and management of private-sector-commissioned projects.
- **Design, editing, and distribution** of printed and digital material, including publications and printing services.
- **Marketing and distribution of products** bearing the AUEB brand, with exclusive rights.
- **Management and coordination** of cooperation agreements between AUEB and external organizations or enterprises.
- **Provision of production** and advertising services.

The Company's Board of Directors promotes a strategic approach that goes beyond the management of real estate and extends to the promotion of the University's intellectual output, making a substantial contribution to the development and outward orientation of the Institution.

# Connection with the Labor Market and Entrepreneurship

## Student Support Unit

The Internship and Career Office operates within the Student Support Unit, catering to students and graduates of the Institution's undergraduate and postgraduate programs. Its primary goal is to support AUEB students and alumni and facilitate their integration into the labor market. The Office also offers counseling services to students and graduates to assist them in making decisions regarding their professional and educational future.

## Internship and Career Office

### Internship Office

The mission of the Internship program is to promote, in the best possible way, the connection between theory and practice and the transition of student interns from student life to professional life. Internships are an integral part of higher education at AUEB, as all Departments have institutionalized them and included them in their Curriculum. They last 3-6 months and are implemented in three periods (Winter semester, Spring semester, and summer period).

### Career Office

Since 1992, Career Office at AUEB has been a reliable and

strong link between the academic community and the broader economic, business, and social environment, both in Greece and abroad. Within the framework of the multifaceted development of students and graduates, it offers customized counseling services, cycles of workshops, and educational seminars, while also organizing information days and vocational guidance events ("AUEB Career Days"). Through its website, it posts job advertisements through which a particularly large number of students and graduates are successfully placed in jobs each year based on their scientific background and work preferences. In its 30 years of operation, Career Office has supported approximately 90,000 AUEB students and graduates, offering a suite of services for information, education, and connection with the labor market. On an annual basis, approximately 6,000 students or graduates benefit from its services.

### Student Support Unit

The Student Support Unit hosts the Internship and Career Office, which serves the undergraduate and postgraduate students and alumni of the University. Its main goal is to support AUEB students and graduates and facilitate their integration into the labor market.





## Athens Center for Entrepreneurship and Innovation (ACEin)

The Athens Center for Entrepreneurship and Innovation (ACEin) is an independent unit of the University that reports directly to the Vice Rector for Research. This year marks its 10th anniversary, and has received significant recognition as Greece's leading startup hub, according to "Europe's Leading Startup Hubs 2025", published by the Financial Times and Statista. Through this recognition, ACEin was distinguished as the only Entrepreneurship Center of a Greek university that systematically mobilizes and guides individuals and teams in initiatives that create, strengthen, and develop entrepreneurship both nationally and internationally.

The Unit comprises the Technology Transfer Office and the Incubator, aiming to support new business ventures and research teams in developing and implementing their innovative business ideas. A core strategic goal of ACEin is to contribute to the creation of an innovation ecosystem that produces competitive know-how and guides the develop-

ment of high-value products and services for both domestic and global markets.

### Target Audience

- Entrepreneurial teams that prioritize innovation as a strategic driver and seek market-based opportunities
- Research teams aiming to commercialize their research results by exploring technological prospects through analysis of technology readiness and the degree of innovation of their outcomes
- Young scientists and researchers with advanced training and specialization

ACEin operates across four strategically important pillars:

- Entrepreneurship Education
- Incubation & Acceleration
- Technology Transfer
- Industry Connection & Networking

# University life

The Athens University of Economics and Business provides a wide range of services to support its students. The University prioritizes both the intellectual development of students and ensuring high-quality living conditions on campus.

## Academic Advisor

Each Department has an appointed Academic Advisor, designated by the Department Assembly, responsible for guiding and advising students regarding their studies. Academic Advisors (faculty members and laboratory teaching staff) hold office hours, announced outside their offices, during which students can seek guidance and clarification on academic matters.

## Student Welfare Directorate

The Student Welfare Directorate is responsible for:

- (a) the provision of student welfare services,
- (b) the provision of student support services, and
- (c) the management of administrative procedures for educational cooperation programs.

The Directorate of Student Welfare is structured into the following organizational units:

1. the Student Support Unit
2. the Student Club and Athens Student Dormitory Support Department
3. the Equal Access Unit for Students with Disabilities and Special Educational Needs
4. the Student Ombudsman Support Office

## Student Club

### Purpose

The AUEB Student Club, governed by its Board of Directors, aims to improve student living conditions, promote recreation, and enhance social and intellectual development through participatory initiatives and social engagement.

To fulfill this purpose, the Club provides essential infrastructure for:

**Accommodation:** Free accommodation for eligible students at the Athens Student Dormitory (Patission 279-281). Applications are submitted online via the Student Club website.

**Housing Allowance:** Undergraduate students of Greek Higher Education Institutions or EU nationals may receive an annual housing allowance of €1,500, or €2,000 in cases of cohabitation, according to the terms of Ministerial Decision 128839/Z1/19-10-2022. Applications are submitted via the Ministry of Education's online platform.

**Meals:** Free meals for eligible students per Ministerial Decision Φ5/68535/B3/18-6-2012. Daily meals (breakfast,





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lunch, dinner) are provided at the Student Club restaurant from September 1 until the completion of Spring exams, excluding Christmas and Easter holidays. Other members of the University community may dine at a low cost.

**Sports Activities:** Students can access free sports facilities of the Athens Municipality's Culture, Sports & Youth Organization, including indoor swimming pools, basketball and volleyball courts, outdoor athletics tracks, 5x5 football fields, and tennis courts. Applications are submitted online via the Student Club website.

**Cultural Activities:** Students may participate for free in Traditional Dance, Music Ensembles (piano and choir), Theatre Group, Debate Club, Photography Club, Film Club,

and Model United Nations. Applications are submitted online.

**Foreign Language Courses:** Instruction is offered in English, French, German, Spanish, and Russian, as well as Greek as a foreign language for international and Greek diaspora students. Applications are submitted online.

## Health and Mental Health Services

Undergraduate, postgraduate, and doctoral students without alternative healthcare coverage are entitled to full medical and hospital care through the National Health System (E.S.Y.), with costs covered by the National Organization for the Provision of Health Services (E.O.P.Y.Y.).


# Library and Information Center

On the first and second floors of the main building, the Library and Information Center operates to serve all members of the university community. At the Library, students can:

- Visit its facilities (Reading Rooms, Research Books Section, Periodicals Section, Documentation Centers) for on-site study.
- Become members through a registration process, enabling them to borrow books from the library's collections as well as from other partner libraries.
- Search for books, articles, and other resources through the OPAC catalog, subscription-based digital collections, and open-access sources.
- Navigate the Library's website for information on operations, library, and available services.
- Access the digital library remotely (from home or work) via a Virtual Private Network (VPN) service.
- Attend training seminars on using information resources and library services and participate in its activities.
- Use the "Ask Us" service via the website to submit questions.
- Consult trained library staff for personalized guidance, either remotely or in person, on using information tools, electronic resources, and locating printed materials.



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## Directorate of Digital Governance

### Network Operations Center- NOC

The Network Operations Center- (NOC) at AUEB include the design, operation, maintenance, and improvement of data and voice networks; the installation and management of telecommunications equipment, cabling infrastructure, and active network devices; the management of the University's central network services such as email, the WiFi network, VPN service, the e-class system, etc.; the development of new network applications; and the operation of tele-education and teleconferencing rooms.

### Department of Integrated Information Systems

The Department of Integrated Information Systems supports the Institution's critical Information Systems (such as the Student Registry, the human resources management system, the electronic

document management and electronic protocol system, the Financial Management System, etc.). It ensures their effective operation, records the institution's needs, evaluates existing functionalities, and designs expansions or new applications. It also ensures their interoperability with other Information Systems both within and outside the organization.

### Computer Center

AUEB possesses a modern Computer Center that continuously upgrades its technological infrastructure and the services it offers, both qualitatively and quantitatively. It features high-performance computing systems and three (3) central teaching and practical training laboratories with a total capacity of 150 workstations. These laboratories are equipped with modern ceiling projectors and microphone installations.

# AUEB Alumni Network

The Athens University of Economics and Business (AUEB) has a long and remarkable tradition of cultivating top leaders in the fields of economics, society, politics, and research. Thousands of AUEB alumni today hold leadership positions in Greece and internationally, across universities, research institutes, international organizations, and major public and private sector enterprises.

Recognizing the importance of maintaining ongoing relationships with its alumni, AUEB created the **Alumni Network**, designed to reconnect graduates with the University and with each other.

## Alumni Network – Connect >> Grow >> Inspire

The **AUEB Alumni Network** was established in 2019 on the occasion of the celebration of the University's 100th anniversary and operates through the digital platform [alumni.aueb.gr](http://alumni.aueb.gr). Among other features, the platform provides graduates with the AUEB Alumni Badge, the University's innovative digital alumni credential, which allows them to verify their degree with a single click and can be used in a digital signature, on platforms such as LinkedIn, and on their résumé.

The main objectives of the Network include:

- **Reconnecting with former classmates** and building ties with alumni in related fields.
- **Staying informed about news, initiatives, and events** of the University addressed to alumni.

- **Access to professional opportunities** through job postings and positions that are not publicly advertised.
- **Career support** through guidance and networking.
- **Participation in volunteer activities**, podcasts/webcasts, and content creation for the newspaper OPA News.

Registration on the platform is simple and includes providing information such as: level of studies (undergraduate/postgraduate/doctoral), contact details, professional profile, and more.

## Alumni Benefits and Services

AUEB alumni enjoy a range of privileges, including:

- **10% discount** on selected continuing education programs offered by **AUEB's KEDIVIM**.
- **Full access to the AUEB Library**, including study facilities, equipment, and both print and digital collections.
- **Ongoing support** through the "Ask Us" service for bibliographic and research inquiries, with direct responses from library staff.
- **Participation in AUEB media**, including webcasts, podcasts, and articles in AUEB OPA News.

AUEB continues to invest in its strong alumni community, fostering relationships built on trust, collaboration, and mutual support, with inspiration and vision for the future.





## Accessibility Unit

The Accessibility Unit falls under the Directorate of Student Welfare and aims to ensure equality, inclusion, and accessibility for all students, in accordance with the requirements of Law 4957/2022 and related ministerial decisions.

### Purpose and Actions:

- Technical and functional interventions for physical and digital accessibility.
- Compliance with the New Building Code and Technical

Guidelines for Persons with Disabilities (PwD).

- Collaboration with students, staff, and sponsors for infrastructure improvements.
- Enhancement of autonomy and full integration of students with disabilities.

AUEB's action toward a more just, sensitive, and accessible university community serves as a model of social responsibility and continuous evolution.

## Virtual Tour of AUEB

Within the framework of the continuous upgrade of provided services and with respect for the principles of social responsibility and accessibility, AUEB leads the way by presenting the first Virtual Walkthrough application in a Greek university.

This innovative application offers visitors the opportunity to digitally navigate the Institution's premises, featuring special signage and infrastructure for Persons with Disabilities (PwD), thereby enhancing accessibility and transparency in the University's operations.

# Social Responsibility

The Athens University of Economics and Business, grounded in timeless values, continuously strengthens its social contribution by adapting its initiatives to the contemporary needs of society. Through targeted programs, AUEB promotes social awareness, protects the environment, and helps reduce social inequalities.

## Pillars of Action

AUEB focuses on initiatives that enhance the quality of life for its students and cultivate a culture of social responsibility, supporting activities related to:

- Scholarships
- Volunteering
- Library Social Services
- Educational Programs
- Publications on Sustainable Development
- Psychosocial Support Seminars
- Socio-Economic and Environmental Sustainability Laboratory
- Innovation Competitions (ACEin, "Nikos Analytis")
- Career Days

## Examples of Socially Responsible Initiatives

- **Voluntary Blood Donation:** Active participation of the university community in collaboration with the P. & A. Kyriakou Children's Hospital.
- **Collaboration with ERMIS (Charitable Association for People with Disabilities):** Joint initiatives for disability awareness, technological support, and organizing a charity concert to purchase a specialized bus.
- **Gender Equality Committee:** Promotes equality in all aspects of University operations.

- **Special Equipment and Personnel:** Donation of a specialized van by MOTODYNAMIC for transporting students with mobility impairments and hiring a librarian to support digital accessibility for students with disabilities.
- **Web Accessibility:** Adapting the University website to meet modern accessibility standards for people with disabilities.
- **Community Tutoring:** Students provide lessons to vulnerable social groups.
- **Outreach Programs to Remote Communities:** In collaboration with Grant Thornton, offering academic and professional guidance to students on remote islands.
- **AUEB Run:** Sports and health events to promote neighborhood safety.
- **Response in cases of physical disasters:** Financial support, donation of materials, and essential goods.
- **Equipment Donations:** Computers provided to schools and institutions.
- **Socially-Oriented Events:** Talks on human rights, bullying, homelessness, charity bazaars, and more.
- **Environmental Awareness:** Energy savings, recycling, and energy efficiency upgrades for buildings.
- **Communication via "OPA News":** Highlighting social responsibility topics to the University community.
- **Summer School for Youth Entrepreneurship:** Training young people in core principles of management and innovation.



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## AUEB Volunteers Program

The Athens University of Economics and Business believes in the importance of the social role and active participation of students, faculty, and administrative staff in promoting social contribution. In this context, in September 2017, AUEB launched the “AUEB Volunteers” Program, a strategic initiative aimed at raising awareness of social issues and enhancing the value of volunteer action.

### Goals and Values

The main goal of the program is to raise awareness within the university community about the 17 UN Sustainable Development Goals (SDGs), promoting participation and practical contribution. Through its activities, the program seeks to build an active community that contributes to social progress and supports the maintenance of University infrastructure.

### Actions and Volunteer Fields

The program’s activities are organized around two main axes:

1. Actions for the AUEB Community
  - This concerns maintenance and improvement of University facilities, focusing on aesthetics and functionality.
2. Actions for Society
  - Organization of the ERMIS Student Competition for high school seniors.
  - Guidance for prospective students on completing their university application forms.
  - Support of innovative entrepreneurial initiatives through the Technology Transfer and Innovation Unit – ACEin Center.
  - Participation in AUEB Career Days.
  - Cultural activities, such as traditional dance groups and music ensembles.
  - Organization and participation in sports events.
  - Development of innovative digital media and applications.

- Innovative initiatives and technological support.
- Since 2021, AUEB has been implementing innovative projects focused on accessibility and digital information:

**Virtual Walkthrough:** A virtual tour application with special accessibility features for people with disabilities (PwD), offering live in-person and digital guided tours. This pioneering service facilitates accessibility and information for the University community.

**Digital Applications and Social Networks:** Development of podcasts, webcasts, and student-created content to actively communicate and showcase university life.

**AUEB Gen Z:** A team of young students collaborating with the Communications Department to create content and enhance communication, placing the new generation at the center of initiatives.

### Recognition and Awards for Volunteer Contribution

Student participation in volunteering is recognized and rewarded through the annual Volunteering Awards Ceremony. Since 2021, the Volunteering Excellence Award has been established and is presented to distinguished volunteers for their outstanding and continuous contribution.

In conclusion, volunteering at AUEB constitutes a practical expression of social responsibility and civic engagement, strengthening the academic community and contributing to the creation of a better, fairer, and more sustainable world. Students have the opportunity to actively participate in a wide range of activities, gain valuable experience, and make a meaningful contribution to social progress.

# International Recognition & Rankings

AUEB places strong emphasis on internationalization, aiming to become the most extroverted university in Greece with high global recognition. The University's strategic priorities cover all aspects of internationalization.

## Strengthening the University's International Presence

The University works systematically to achieve the following goals:

- Improve rankings of undergraduate and postgraduate programs in international ranking systems (e.g., QS, Shanghai, Eduniversal).
- Participation in prestigious international higher education fairs, such as NAFSA 2025 in California, USA.
- Operation of an English-language undergraduate program ("Bachelor in International Business and Technology") offered fully in English and exclusively for foreign students who have completed high school abroad.
- Collaboration with foreign institutions, hosting international student groups in Greece for short-term programs and connecting them with AUEB students. Recent examples include partnerships with William & Mary (USA), Kelley School of Business, Indiana University (USA), and Drexel University (USA).
- Offer of dual (double) or joint degrees at the postgraduate and doctoral levels, e.g., collaborations of the Department of Statistics with Pavia University (Italy) and Stevens Institute of Technology (USA), and the English-taught MSc in International Shipping, Finance and Management with EDHEC Business School (France).
- Signing memoranda of cooperation with universities abroad (USA, UK, China, Vietnam, Germany, Belgium, Canada, Taiwan, etc.).
- Organization of summer schools, such as:
- "Digital Entrepreneurship" with Michigan State University (USA)
- "Human Rights Law, Policy and Practice: Britain, Greece and the EU" with Goldsmith's University (UK) and other Greek universities
- "Digital Humanities for Hellenic Studies" with Princeton University (USA)
- Opportunities for AUEB students to attend summer schools abroad, e.g., SWUFE Summer Camp (China).
- Acquisition of additional international accreditations (e.g.,

AACSB), building on existing ones (AMBA, AACSB, EQUIS).

- Participation in prestigious international university networks, such as the Hermes Network, where AUEB is the only Greek member.
- Courses taught by distinguished international scholars.
- Recognition of research published in top-tier international journals.

Since 2024, AUEB has also become a global hub for the Kelley School of Business, Indiana University (USA), hosting Kelley students in Athens for a semester, with credits transferred to their home institution.

## International Rankings

The evaluation criteria used by international bodies for ranking universities mainly include academic reputation, employer reputation, indicators of research quality, international collaborations, international accreditation of study programs, among others. The most recent major distinctions of AUEB as a "Business School" are the following:


## Erasmus+ Programme

The Athens University of Economics and Business, leading the way, has been initiating student exchanges through the Erasmus Programme since as early as 1987. Today, the Institution is one of the most active Greek universities in the Programme, with annual participation exceeding 300 outgoing and 470 incoming students, respectively. Approximately 70 undergraduate courses are taught in English, while more than 220 inter-institutional agreements have been concluded at the Erasmus+ level, which are continuously re-evaluated and upgraded.

## Business Confucius Institute

The Business Confucius Institute in Athens was founded in 2009 at AUEB in collaboration with the University of International Busi-

ness and Economics (UIBE) in Beijing and the Office of Chinese Language Council International (HANBAN). It is the first Confucius Institute in Greece and the third in Europe with a focus on economics and business administration. It offers Chinese language courses of all levels, certification exams for students and teachers, seminars, calligraphy workshops, and lectures on history and culture, while also granting scholarships for studies in China. In its fifteen years of operation, it has taught the Chinese language to more than 3,500 trainees and has granted more than 250 full study scholarships. Its main goal is to serve as a bridge of cooperation and communication between Greece and China and to contribute to cultural rapprochement and the further development of educational, research, and economic collaborations between the two countries.



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## Infrastructure

The Athens University of Economics and Business is located in the heart of Athens, a city that combines a rich historical and cultural heritage with the dynamism of a modern metropolis. As the cradle of democracy, science, and the arts, Athens offers students a unique environment where world-renowned historical monuments coexist with the vibrant energy of contemporary urban life.

Since its establishment, AUEB has been headquartered in the city center, at the intersection of Patission Avenue (28th October Street) and Alexandras Avenue, next to Pedion tou Areos Park. The University's main building, the historic Marasleio Mansion, is located at 76 Patission Street and occupies an entire city block, bounded by Derigny, Antoniadou, and Mavromateon streets.

AUEB also operates additional buildings to support its teaching and research activities on nearby streets such as Kodrigktonos, Elpidos, and Derigny. The Postgraduate Studies and Research Center is housed in a modern building at 47 Evelpidon Street and Lefkados Street. In addition, since 2017, a new building complex has been operating in Kypseli, at 2 Troias Street and Spetses Street, with a total area of approximately 5,000 square meters, covering the institution's increased needs.

Thanks to its central location, access to the University's facilities is particularly easy, with direct connections to all forms of public transportation.
