PROFESSIONAL EXPERIENCE

Head of the IT Department of the AUEB (1997 – 2014)

For many years he was in charge of the IT department of the Library of Athens University of Economics and Business. He contributed significantly to the automation of bibliographic catalog by installing a library management system. He consequently contributed to the design and implementation of the Library's integrated information system, which nowadays offers up-to-date and integrated services of electronic information to all the members of the academic community. He has also served as deputy head of the Library.

He was the project manager of "Upgrade and expansion of the Library Information system of AUEB" undertaken by the Library and directed by professor Mr. E. J. Yannakoudakis, in the framework of the 3rd CSF, Phase II. Among other responsibilities in this project, he took on:

- The upgrade of the infrastructure of the Library's information system, by obtaining and installing new servers and work stations for the staff and the users of the Library.
- The upgrade of the bibliographical database of the Library, by installing "Horizon" integrated library system.
- The development of software tools for the formatting of the bibliographical records, based on the international standard ISO2709 (UNIMARC) in a way that they conform with the standards of the union catalogue of Hellenic Academic Libraries.
- The design and development of an integrated system of managing multilingual thesauri, by which was achieved the automation of the MACROTHESAURUS and EUROVOC thesauri that the Library of the AUEB uses.
- The design and implementation of a Barcode Management System for the Library's material.
- The upgrade of the Library's web site so that it constitutes a modern tool of electronic information for all the members of the academic community of the AUEB.
- The supervision of the Digitization of the historical "Economic and Social Sciences Archive" of D. Kalitsounakis, as well as of the AUEB's reference books.

During the years 2010-2015, he participated as coordinator in the Library's project "Contemporary services of the Library of AUEB", supervised and directed by professor Mr P. Constantopoulos. In the framework of this project of digitized convergence, the following services were developed:

- Institutional Repository / Digitized Library
- Digitization of unique and educational material and its deposition in the institutional repository.
- Up-to-date services of identifying, access in and managing of the areas and the collections of the Library by means of the RFID technology.
- Processing and formatting of the bibliographical records for the participation of the AUEB's Library in the ILSAS service.

In Charge of the Design and Development of Library Management Systems(1992-1997)

He was for many years the project manager of designing and developing the integrated library management system "Libretto". He has been trained in Israel by the Exlibris company in installation and configuration of the Aleph LMS and possesses excellent knowledge of the library standards (ISO2709, UNIMARC, MARC21, DUBLIN-CORE, AACR2, ISBD).

He has offered significant services to the automation of the libraries in many public organisations

the most important of which being:

- **Library of the Presidency of the Hellenic Republic:** He carried through the main part of his military service in the military office of the Presidency of the Hellenic Republic (during the presidency of Mr Constantinos Stefanopoulos) in the course of which he automated the bibliographical catalogue of the Presidency's Library and he organized the Library's material based on the international Dewey Decimal Classification (DDC). What is more, he contributed to the designing of the Presidency's web site.
- **Library of the Konstantinos G. Karamanlis Foundation:** He automated the bibliographical catalogue of the Library by installing the Libretto LMS and he trained the librarians in the material's cataloguing. He collaborated with Ms Fessa in creating a multilingual thesaurus in reference to the history of Macedonia. He also designed and supervised the development of software for the automation of the personal archive of Konstantinos Karamanlis.
- **Library of the Center of Planning and Economic Research (KEPE):** He automated the bibliographical catalogue of the Library by installing the Libretto LMS; he trained the librarians in using it and supervised the retrospective cataloguing of the material.
- **Library of the Eugenides Foundation:** He automated the bibliographical catalogue of the Library by installing the Libretto LMS; he undertook the migration of the data from the old system and trained the Library's staff.
- **Library of the Centre of Study and Research of the Greek Theatre-Greek Museum:** He automated the bibliographical catalogue of the Library by installing the Libretto LMS and trained the Library's staff.
- **Public Library of Holargos:** He automated the bibliographical catalogue of the Library by installing the Libretto LMS system and undertook the migration of data from the old system to the new; he also trained the staff of the Library.
- **Public Library of Kozani:** He automated the bibliographical catalogue of the Library by installing the Libretto LMS and trained the staff of the Library. He undertook the formatting of the bibliographical records based on the UNIMARC standard with a view to their migration from the ABEKT system.
